

Welcome to Tui Ridge and congratulations on your engagement.

Tui Ridge is a unique private garden setting. With views to the Kaimai Ranges means you are spoilt for choice when deciding on the perfect position to say your wedding vows. Whether you choose the quaint summer house, under an oak tree or simply having the Kaimai Ranges as your backdrop, the decision is yours.



After the ceremony, guests can mingle and listen to our resident Tui's, celebrate with a drink or explore the gardens whilst you have your photo's. Your romantic garden wedding can continue on with informal dining under the trees, supplied by a food caravan or maybe you will choose to dine elsewhere.



Tui Ridge is located at the end of a long treelined driveway that winds itself through a Kiwi fruit orchard. As we have limited parking up in the gardens we ask that the majority of your guests come by shuttle bus or vans.

With large shelter trees surrounding the garden but with views to the Kaimai Ranges its one of the most beautiful of the very few self catering wedding venues available in the Bay of Plenty. This allows you to choose your own caterers and supply your own alcohol.

As we are a private residence we operate until the sun goes down, so everybody needs to leave before sundown.

Included in the price you get rustic ceremony seating located at your choice of position in the garden. This seats approximately 30 guests and there is unlimited space for many more guests to stand under the large specimen trees. We provide portable gazebo cover incase of light rain weather (unable to be used in strong wind) for up to 50 guests (standing room) The summer house is a great permanent structure that can be used for drinks/food.

There is an area for preparation of food platters (no cooking) and a private bathroom for the bride to use.

The garden looks its best from November (roses are flowering) to May. It suits picnic style or food caravan type of weddings or events. We have found the more that is added to the garden (structure wise) there is less of an open relaxed feel to it. We have priced accordingly for this, if you are looking to have a sit down meal - we suggest to dine elsewhere.

## Booking terms and conditions

- 1. To confirm your booking a <u>non-refundable</u> deposit of \$500 is required.
- 2. Remaining balance to be paid no later than 1 month prior to the function
- 3. Cancellations must be in writing and be acknowledged in writing by the management of Tui Ridge. Any cancellation made within 1 month of the function forfeits any payments made.
- 4. The hirer shall be responsible for the Health and Safety of all those attending the event. The venue has uneven terrain and surfaces. Please ensure you have a plan for catering for guests with mobility issues.
- 5. Tui Ridge does not supply, sell or serve alcohol as part of our venue hire. The hirer is responsible for the safe, sensible and moderate serving and consumption of alcohol to their guests. The hirer must appoint/hire at least one dedicated Bar person for the duration of your event. All rubbish, empties, glassware and recycling to be removed after the function.
- 6. The hirer shall be liable for any loss or damage to the grounds or fixtures and fittings done by any person attending the function.
- 7. Tui Ridge shall not be liable for any damage or loss to any property belonging to or under control of the hirer or any injury to those using the venue
- 8. All children must be fully supervised by a parent or caregiver. Tui Ridge will not be responsible for any injuries around the venue.
- 9. Caterers must be fully self contained.
- 10. The premises will be available from time that is booked for on day of hire. Functions must conclude and all guests departed by sundown.
- 11. Hirers must remain at the function until the conclusion, when the hirer leaves the function, (either the premises or to their accommodation) the function is deemed to have concluded.
- 12. Tui Ridge reserves the right to alter or make improvements to the property.
- 13. The hirer must abide by all local bylaws and regulations, eq noise control, fire bans etc
- 14. Force Majeure. Tui Ridge shall not be liable for failing or delaying performance of its obligations resulting from any condition beyond it's reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of terrorism, earthquake, fire, flood, bad weather or other acts of God.
